




## BC Overdose Deaths 1992 – Nov. 30, 2018








### **Death Review Panel Findings**




 Reviewed cases of 1,854 people who died from illicit drug overdose (Jan 2016-July 2017)

#### • Key findings for the majority of cases:

- Recent health care and/or previous BC corrections contact
- Using substances regularly
- ➤ Using alone
- Many had sought treatment in past and
  - experienced relapses
- Opioid agonist therapy <u>protective</u> against death







# Patients on Opioid Agonist Therapy, BC






