Client Criteria for Clozapine Initiation

Adult Mental Health Teams/EPI/ACT

- Primary care provider
- Stable housing
- Family Support OR highly reliable and adherent
- ❖ NO medical complications
 - For example: Diabetes, active liver disease, active seizure disorder, cardiovascular disease, blood dyscrasia, pregnancy, history or clozapine-induced cardiac OR hematologic complication

VENTURE

- Primary care provider
- Not reliable, history of noncompliance
- MILD medical complications
 - For example: Stable cardiovascular disease or well-controlled seizure disorder, history of "yellow alerts" on clozapine, history of constipation

ACUTE INPATIENT Psychiatry

- Not attached to primary care
- Poor community support
- High risk for non-adherence
- MODERATE medical complications
 - For example: Diabetes, history of seizures, hepatitis, risk for substance use

BC PSYCHOSIS Program

- Uncertainty about diagnosis or appropriateness of clozapine
- Poor community support
- Lack of insight or ongoing substance use
- Clozapine resistance
- ❖ SEVERE medical complications
 - o For example: History of myocarditis or neutropenia
