Dear Treatment Optimization of Psychosis (TOP) Collaborative,

Over the past year our teams have worked together towards the common goal of optimizing treatment for people living with psychosis. Using continuous quality improvement (CQI) strategies, since June 23, 2021, TOP has systematically shared, measured and implemented best practices in the treatment of psychosis in community settings rather than in hospitals.

This work was led by the BC Centre for Excellence in HIV/AIDS (BC-CfE) in partnership with Vancouver Coastal Health Mental Health and Substance Use (VCH MHSU) and the BC Schizophrenia Society.

As the one-year partnership phase of this work comes to an end, TOP leadership has decided to continue the TOP initiative at VCH, integrated within VCH MHSU, effective August 12, 2022. This transition of the TOP program to VCH will ensure the best use of the remaining funds reserved for this initiative, and provide long-term, sustainable integration within VCH MHSU services.

This decision means the BC-CfE will not be involved with TOP after August 12, 2022. All TOP-related inquires after August 12 should be directed to:
